Description:

Soilguard originally tested as PST-4CU3 is a hard fescue developed for a multitude of applications within the turf grass industry. Soilguard has good drought tolerance, medium vertical growth rate, and good resistance to stem rust and melting out disease. Soilguard has a medium bright green color and has moderate to good shade tolerance. Soilguard has tolerance to 8-16 oz./acre (.58-1.16 liter/hectare) rates of glyphosate.

Applications:

Soilguard can be used by itself or in blends with other fine fescues. It is also performs well in mixtures with other cool season species such as perennial ryegrass, and Kentucky bluegrass.

Soilguard is an excellent choice for stabilizing steep slopes and adding stability to highly erodible ground. It provides a very appealing ground cover for golf course roughs and landscape areas when allowed to grow to a full mature height of 12-18" (30-45 cm.)

For most new applications a seeding rate of 2-4 lbs./1,000 sq. ft. (97-195 kg/ha) is adequate. Under normal conditions full establishment can be expected in 14-21 days.

First mowing an occur at 3-5" (7-12 cm.)

Geographical Adaption:

Soilguard has a wide range of adaptability. From the transition zone to northern climates Soilguard will perform quite well. It has good cold tolerance while displaying good heat and drought tolerance in non-irrigated sites.
